CONDITIONS

CL6 – This approval is granted on the condition that the primary purpose of the shooting club is to be regularly conduct sport target shooting events as a club. The only weapons permitted for possession and use by the club members are to be of a Category approved by the Authorised Officer, Weapon's Licensing. The shooting club is to furnish the Authorised Officer, Weapons Licensing with a list identifying the financial status of members of the club upon written request or by other arrangement with the Authorised Officer, Weapons Licensing. If the club is approved for possession and use of Category H Weapons, the club must hold six Category H handgun shooting competitions to be conducted on different days in each financial year for each class of Category H Weapons possessed by the members of the club. The club is also to supply on written request by an Authorised Officer a member's participation record, if the member is a licensed owner of Category H Weapons for the purpose of sport target shooting.

999 – This club is approved for possession and use of Category A Weapons, Category B Weapons, Category C (Shotgun) Weapons and Category H Weapons for Sports Target Shooting. The full and correct business name for this approval is Sporting Shooters' Association of Australia Rockhampton Branch Inc.

The current representative for this approval is Grant NOLAN.
