CONDITIONS

RR5 – This approval is granted on the condition that the range will be used for sport or target shooting and/or conducting training courses approved by the Commissioner for Sections 10A(2) or 124 of the Weapons Act 1990, and/or any person/s exempted under Section 2 of the Weapons Act 1990.

No category of weapon is to be used on the range that has not been approved for use on the range by the Authorised Officer, Weapons Licensing. No category of weapon is to be used on the range that has not been approved for use on the range by the Authorised Officer, Weapons Licensing. No course of fire or type of shooting is to be conducted on the range that has not been approved for use by the Authorised Officer, Weapons Licensing.

At least one Range Officer, appointed by the Range Operator, is to be present on the range at all times when a weapon is discharged. The Range Operator must provide the Authorised Officer, within 14 days of the holder first becoming aware, or suspecting, that a "prescribed event" has happened at the range, written notice of the event. The notice may only relate to injury or damage caused by a firearm used at the range, other than damage to a target or thing designed as a bullet barrier.

A "prescribed event" means an injury to a person or damage to property at or in the vicinity of a shooting range. The Range Operator must ensure that warning signs are permanently displayed at the range entrance and all other paths, tracks or entry points into the range and any range danger area. The Range Operator must ensure

that a copy of the Range Standing Orders are prominently displayed at the range and made freely available to all persons attending the range.

The Range Operator must ensure that before any person uses the range to discharge a weapon, that red flags by day or red lights or illuminated red flags by night are displayed at the range entrance and to the immediate rear of the main firing line (flags to be no less than 1.2m by 0.9m). The red flags must be lowered or removed and red lights turned off when the range is no longer being used to discharge weapons.

RS9 - Muzzle velocity of ammunition used not to exceed 4100 feet per second (1250 metres/second) for centrefire and blackpowder weapons. Muzzle energy of ammunition used not to exceed 4182 foot pounds (5675 joules) for centrefire and blackpowder weapons.

RS9 - Muzzle velocity of ammunition used not to exceed 2400 feet per second (610 metres/second) for rim fire weapons. Muzzle energy of ammunition used not to exceed 350 foot pounds (434 joules) for rim fire weapons.

999 - This range approval only permits and use of Category A Weapons, B Weapons, C (Shotgun) and H Weapons for training and sport target shooting. Category C (Rim fire) Weapons and D weapons only permitted for firearms training purposes. The range approval is for the 300 metre rifle range.

This is a soft target range. Any hard or metal targets must be defended by non-penetrable splatter guards which prevent ricochet of projectiles from the range.
